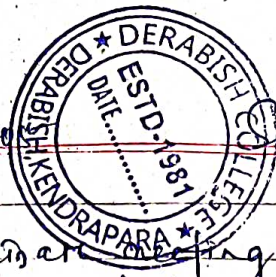
Abstract



Cancer is a complex group of the disease characterized by uncontrolled growth and spread of abnormal cells. Cancer can vary widely in terms of their genetic and molecular characteristics, site of origin and response to treatment. This heterogeneity requires a personalized approach to cancer diagnosis and management. The revolution in Cancer treatment is driven by advance genomics, immunotherapy, targeted therapies and precision medicines. Genomics profiling allows for identification of specific genetic mutation and alterations in tumour, enabling targeted therapies that inhibit the function of particular oncogene or protein involved in cancer progression. Additionally, early detection and screening program, plays a vital role in improving survival rates. Ongoing research on cancer stem cells, drug resistance and tumour micro- environment is expected to yield new insight and innovative treatment strategies.

Banking sector crisis in America- it's impact on Indian Economy

Abstract :

Fearing the brutal recession that ensued during the lockdown would be similar to that of The Great Recession of 2007-2009, the U.S. Fed and Government brought about some changes that led to the economy staging an unexpected recovery instead of a prolonged downturn such as

1. Government Aid Infusion
2. Emergency Intervention by Fed by slashing interest rates
3. Joe Biden's \$1.9 Trillion Covid Relief Packages with \$1400 in cash disbursed to most of the households which increased the purchasing power parity to a large extent in consumer households

This led to businesses struggling to meet demand, inadequate labour forces, insufficient supplies due to high costs which was ultimately thrust on the consumer leading to the pressure valve called Inflation.

While the Fed Reserve thought the sudden spike in inflation would be transitory, it has glued on like a leech for a long time.

And thus commenced The Great American Banking Crisis with the fall of Silicon Valley Bank, Signature Bank and the recent First Republic Bank

The Banking Crisis

The fall of these U.S. Banks can be related to that of the Domino Effect. Following is the summary of the major reasons leading to the fall of these banks

Silicon Valley Bank

Due to major slashing of interest rates, huge sums of money were infused into start-ups by Venture Capitalists and PE firms which were parked as deposits in


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the start up darling, SVB, additionally, the bank was also paying higher than industry average interest rates. Although the deposits tripled, loans only doubled due to abundance of money leading to a classic Asset Liability mismatch. Majority of these surplus funds, instead of being invested in short term government bonds ensuring liquidity were greedily infused in long term government bonds with higher yield. A large chunk of these investments were classified under the Held To Maturity (i.e. HTM) category. Hence, as fed fund rates rose, yield curve inversion transpired leading to major fall in bond prices which in turn lead to large amount of notional loss. Normally, this wouldn't be a problem, as this is just a paper loss but due to the Silvergate affair, startup winter arrived leading to VC's tapping out money and hence, all the investments had to be immediately liquidated at losses to calm down the storm of bank runs.

Signature Bank

Even though this bank was America's 19th Largest Bank dealing with HNI's in real estate, law, cryptocurrencies, including being associated with the Trump organisation company, the bank could not withstand the contagion effect after the collapse of SVB bank.

While one of the main reasons were 90% of uninsured deposits, liquidity risk and lack of FDIC Oversight, various sources also reveal that regulators just took over it to serve as a warning of U.S. Banks to avoid cryptocurrency dealings.

First Republic Bank

Apart from exposure to uninsured deposits (almost 2/3rd of deposits) and the contagion effect, the bank also had an unusually large Loan to deposit ratio of 111%.

What next for the US Economy?

While the US Fed fund rates are at a 16 year high and the Fed Chairman hints at anticipating further rate increases, the World Economic Forum predicts that the Fed Reserve will hold steady for the rest of 2023 after the 25bps hike in May which can also lead to a short and shallow recession this year.


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The stress in mid-sized banks can be a liquidity shock and not solvency concern.

While the FDIC has ensured that all the deposits will be repaid back to depositors over and above the standard limit of \$2,50,000 and no losses will be borne by taxpayers, the Fed strongly believes that the banks that collapsed were outlier banks and the banking system is quite robust.

Impact on India

While the banking indices are facing selling pressure which could lead to further depreciation of the Rupee, the tedious yet robust framework designed by RBI ensures that Indian Banks cannot be easily affected by such situations. The liquidity coverage ratio introduced by RBI ensures bank holds ample, high quality assets to get through stressed funding situations such as deposit runs. The capital adequacy ratio maintained by Indian Banks is also very prudent, the ratios maintained by Indian banks are higher than the recommended Basel III Norms. Apart from this, among institutional categories, over 60% deposits in Indian Banks are held by the household sector. This means that a large sum of deposit money is sticky money which are not prone to flights of despair like that of SVB Bank. More importantly, there is only small portion of deposits set aside for investments in Indian banks due to the large loan to deposits ratio. While the HTM securities are measured at amortized cost, reflecting no notional losses on paper, on a prudent basis, Indian Banks also set aside a portion of their profits earned from AFS and HFT securities into investment fluctuation reserves. RBI also mandates disclosing the Asset Liability Management (ALM) System which gives us a fair idea on the likely mismatches. Due to the proactive risk management by RBI all the banking parameters seem to be very healthy. The positive indicators like constant expansion in net interest margins, significant improvement in asset quality with Net NPA contracting to a decade low, consequential credit growth also give fair idea of isolation of the Indian financial system to the ongoing financial crisis. Apart from the obvious investment sentiment getting hurt, there seems to be no domino effect.

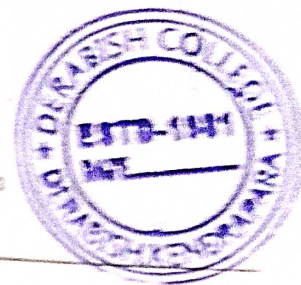
Brief Report on the Event :

Role of Ethnobotany on Indian Society: A Review

ABSTRACT

Abstract—Ethno botany, the research field of science, has been widely used in documenting the indigenous knowledge of using plants and procuring an inventory of useful plants from local ethnic people. Plants that are used as traditional herbal medicine in different countries are an important part of these studies. However, in some countries, ethno botanical studies have been used for the discovery of new medicinal uses and development of pharmaceutical industry. In general, experiences gained from ethno botanical approaches of traditional medicinal studies in China and Himalayan countries have helped in new drug development. At the same time, in many cases, over-harvesting, degradation of medicinal plants, and loss of indigenous traditional knowledge from local communities are common problems in these resource areas. Issues of indigenous knowledge, intellectual property rights, and uncontrolled transboundary trade in medicinal plants occur frequently in the region. This paper reviews the role of ethno botanical approaches of traditional medicinal studies, in reference to the society, with an emphasis on the conservation of traditional medical knowledge and medicinal plant resource. In recent era, the investigation on ethnobotany to fulfill the increasing demand of plant extracts and herbal products. It has been reported that about 20,000 plant species are found in Indian flora having different medicinal properties and more than this have other ethnobotanical importance. Of which about 7% are on the verge of extinction. According to the recent findings of Botanical Survey of India (BSI), over 300 species of angiosperms are under threat of extinction. Therefore it is essential to investigate such plants from different unexplored regions and collect the indigenous knowledge regarding their utilities.

1. INTRODUCTION

India is a vast country with a variety of topographies, climates, vegetation, and people.

In India, ethnobotany can be divided into two groups of people, i.e. those living in small cities or rural villages and tribal peoples who live in remote villages. The population of India is approximately 102 million, out of which about 50 million people belong to 550 tribal communities or aboriginals. There are 325 total languages with a large number of dialects spoken within the country, of which 18 are official including English, Sanskrit, and Urdu.


In Asia, there are various written accounts which testify to the usefulness of Himalayan herbs for medicinal purposes. Perhaps the earliest use of herbal plants was documented in the Vedas in about 4500 to 600 B.C. which represents the oldest repository of human knowledge, and comprises 67 plant

species. Ayurveda (a traditional medicine system practiced widely in India and Nepal) provides further details for the therapeutic use of more than herbal drugs (Manaballur, 1990). In China, Sheng-Nong Herbal book is suggested to be one of the earliest source of folk knowledge on the use of herbs; it comprises 365 plants, animals, and minerals used as medication from the period of Sheng-Nong (3000 B.C.) (Pai, 1987). Recent studies on Tibetan medicine have shown that the earliest literature on Tibetan medicine was in the eighth century A.D. (Yang, 1983). The system of Unani Medicine in South and West Asia also has very long tradition and is being practiced in different countries. In Asian countries, it is evident from the ancient literature as well as scientific records of ITK that plants are the important source of medicinal system and also in the health care of humans.

It has also been evidenced from China that Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM) includes 11,145 species, of which 92 species are cultivated and the remaining 11,053 species are wild plants (SEPA, 1997). According to the World Health Organization (WHO), more than 80% of the world's population relies on traditional herbal medicine for their primary health care needs (Ingis, 1994). These valuable herbal traditions found in developing countries have always been considered an important component of the cultural heritage of the world. This indigenous knowledge about medicinal plants has been used for time immemorial for healing process.

Ethnobotany and Society

There has been tremendous transition in the economies from subsistence to market-based in over last quarter century which have created a serious impact on overall aspects of traditional medical systems by affecting indigenous medicines, resource base and environment. Over-harvesting of medicinal plants and animal species has resulted in exploitation, loss of biodiversity, and the loss of indigenous medical knowledge and traditions. This lead to a breakdown of traditional medical systems. Moreover, the exploitation of traditional herbal medicine for the creation and development of new drugs for allopathic treatments which reduces the demand of traditional medicine.

They were discouraged from attending school because it was assumed that they would not be able to put their educational qualifications, skills, and abilities to use in their marital homes.



Introduction.

Violence against women is deeply entrenched global issue with consequences for individuals and society at large. Understanding the causes and concerns associated with this problem is crucial for effectively addressing and preventing it. This description delves into the various facets of violence against women, shedding light on its underlying causes and the concerns it raises.

01. Types of violence Against Women:

- a) Physical Violence: Includes acts like, domestic abuse, sexual assault, and female genital mutilation.
- b) Psychological and Emotional Violence: Involves Manipulation, humiliation, and control often in intimate relationships.
- c) Sexual Violence: Encompasses rape sexual harassmet and trafficking.

03. Concern associated with violence against women:

Physical and Psychological Health: Survivor may suffer physical injuries, mental trauma, and a long-term health consequence.

Economic and social impact: Women may lose their livelihoods, face social isolation, and experience stigma.

Reproductive Health: Sexual violence can result in unwanted pregnancies and spread transmitted diseases.

Human Right Violation: Including right to life, liberty, and security of person.

Underresponding: Fear stigma, and lack of faith in legal systems often lead to this incidents.

Cultural and social barriers: Community and family pressures can deter women from seeking help.

Barrier to Justice: Legal system may be biased, slow inaccessible to survivors.

4. Legal frame work.

(1) Protection of women against Domestic Violence Act, 2005: under this Act, women to be liberated from any type of violence, women can look for financial compensation, right to live in mutual house and they can get maintenance from their abuser in case they are living separated.

This is an act of the Indian Parliament enacted to protect women from any type of violence.

(2) Section 498 A :of the IPC (Indian Penal Code) This is a criminal Law ,which applies to husbands family members of husbands who are merciless to women. compusory. 3 months imprisonment.

(3) Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961: Is a criminal act giving or taking dowry. (6months Imprisonment and can be fined upto Rs.5000/-

Addressing violation against women in recent incident, a auto-rickshaw puller of 32 years of age in the start of Madhyapradesh Ujjain District rapped & murdered a 12years little girl is a heinous & inhuman & barbarous act requires a multi-faceted approach, including legal framework, awareness campaigns, economic empowerment, and cultural shifts, it is a complex issue with far reaching consequences, and addressing its causes and concerns, and is vital for achieving gender equality, justice, and the well-being of women around the world. 
